

Guidelines for Thesis

In view of the COVID-19, pandemic certain modification have been suggested to fulfil the requirement of thesis FFT 591 & FFT 590

Following points are considered for the compilation of thesis work of M.Sc Food Technology/ Nutritional Sciences SEM IV.

Students may prepare their project thesis on the basis of following points:

FOR INDUSTRY BASED PROJECTS

1. Compilation of data of the work done before the lockdown period
2. Topic of thesis may be slightly modified if there is possibility of developing model/analysis of online data (Meta analysis)/HACCP plan etc.
3. Preparation of detail report about the industry (in which they worked) – which may include
 - Background of the industry (product, export-import, Production Status etc.)
 - Basic processing involved
 - Quality assurance (product testing data)
 - Future prospective/ innovative approach /product development /process development/value addition of the products being manufactured.
 - Each student has been allotted a supervisor, student are required to consult their respective supervisor to report their work done till date and for guidance in completion of the thesis.

FOR LAB BASED PROJECTS

1. Writing a review paper of the allotted topic (for lab based thesis)
